What you need to bring with you

Your letter may ask you to bring some specific information or items.

You should also bring;

- A list of medicines, creams, drops or inhalers you currently take
- Any samples we have asked you to bring
- A list of questions if you have any

Please wear loose clothing in case you need to be examined during your consultation.

What to do when you arrive

Once you arrive at the hospital please register with the receptionist. The receptionist will then confirm your details with you and you will then be asked to take a seat and wait until your name is called. During this time, you are welcome to complimentary tea and coffee.

Please tell the receptionist if you need to update any of your personal details, like a new address, GP or mobile phone number.

After the clinic

At the end of your consultation you may be handed a form that you should take to the receptionist. This form contains important information for the receptionist, and will indicate when a follow-up appointment should be booked for you (if one is required).

If your doctor needs to see you again, please make another appointment with the receptionist before you leave.
